Hot off the plane from Japan come two new beauty tricks for summer. **Giorgio Armani's Tokyo Coral nail polishes**, £17.50 at Selfridges, are bold fauvist colours to make your toes stand out in the sand. **Shiseido's Refining Body Exfoliator**, £32, is a hi-tech scrub that smells of cherry blossom. It contains two different types of beads, which dislodge dead cells on contact with skin, so there's no need to scrub yourself silly.

NEAL'S YARD FIRMING ORANGE FLOWER & JASMINE FACIAL

Best for Nature lovers.

The lowdown The gold standard for organic products, Neal's Yard is to skincare what Hugh Fearnley-Whittingstall is to food. This treatment zaps those pesky lines (caused by dehydration) with potent flower extracts, taken from the organic physic garden at the company's Dorset headquarters. Orange flower has long been revered for its nourishing qualities and is used in this treatment in a zingy cleanser, face mask and frankincense and orange-flower moisturiser. The therapist also uses a facial roller to iron those wrinkles away.

Our verdict Organic can deliver the same youthful results as the chemically enhanced brands. Our tester was wowed – her skin went from prunish to peachy in just one session.

HIBISCUS BODY SCRUB AND WRAP

Best for Softening scaly skin.

The lowdown Rivalling the Shangri-La-like spas of Asia, Ushvani is possibly London's most exotic retreat. Huge fish tanks, underground plunge pools and a sweeping wooden staircase make it a heavenly hangout. The spa has recently developed its own line of products centred around the healing hibiscus flower. The Hibiscus Scrub, which sloughs away city grime, is followed by a relaxing massage to ease away tension. The finale is a sweet-smelling, detoxifying wrap that leaves your skin softer than a kitten's tummy.

Our verdict Perfect for smoothing rough, flaky skin suffering from beach burnout. It's just a shame Ushvani is a day spa – we wanted to stay for a week.
